## The Programme

The London Art Book Fair 2018 is embedded within, and a highlight of, the Whitechapel Gallery's autumn programme of exhibitions and events.

The entire ground floor will be dedicated to The Fair – Gallery's 1 & 2 for the four days.

Gallery 3 will be a special bar/magazine zone.

A vibrant programme of talks, discussions, screenings and signings will accompany The Fair and will be taking place in the Zilkha Auditorium (capacity 100).

A Families Weekend will take over the Creative Studio spaces.

We invite exhibitors to launch their new autumn titles with book signings at The Fair, which we will promote as part of the Exhibitor's Programme.

We expect 10,000+ visitors over the four days.

The LABF programme is curated by Whitechapel Gallery's team alongside guest curator Eleanor Vonne Brown.

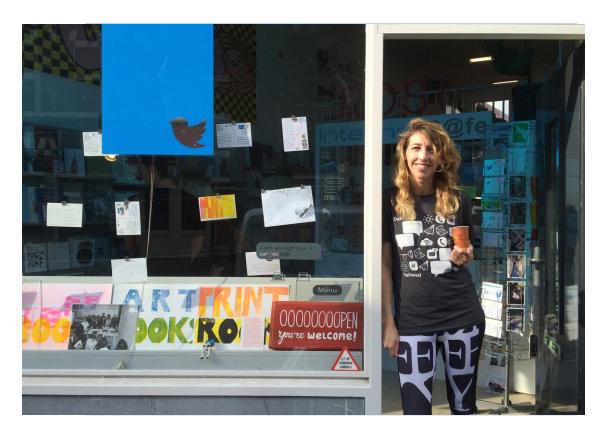

#### Introducing A-Z...

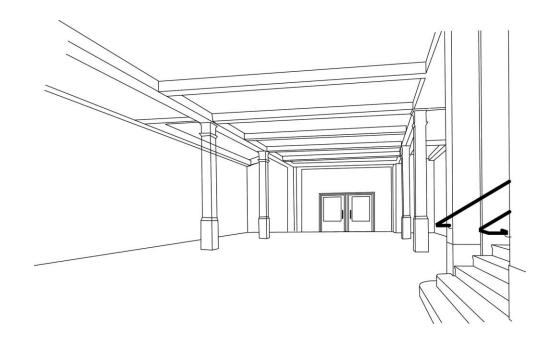
The tables will be organised alphabetically across the two Gallery spaces.

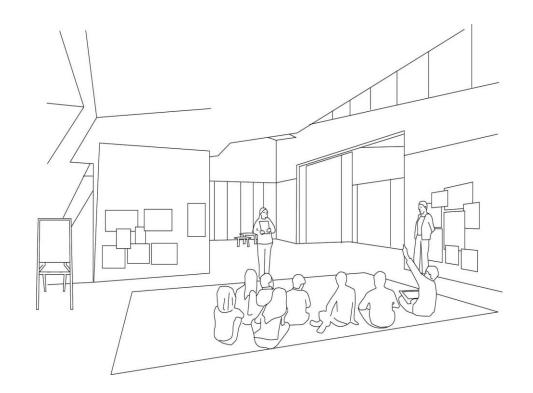
