

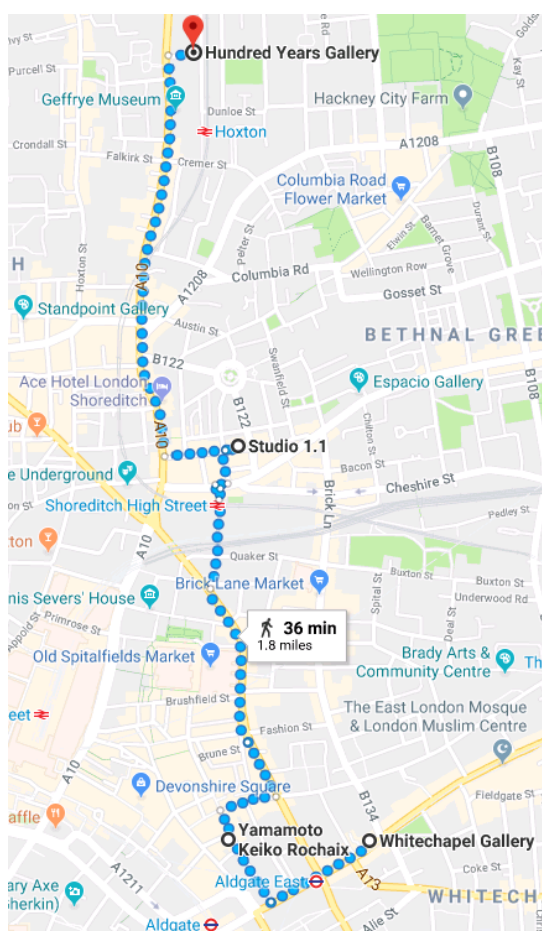
Whitechapel Gallery First Thursdays



Late night art on the first Thursday of every month in east London

July's Walking Tour begins at **Whitechapel Gallery**. Discover emerging art from a diverse city, *The London Open 2018* features 22 artists working across painting, sculpture, performance and video. Free entry to all our summer exhibitions including newly opened *Katja Novitskova: Invasion Curves*, *Killed Negatives: Unseen Images from 1930s America*, *I Self Collection: Bumped Bodies* and *Alone Together: Youth Forum* with Seth Pimlott.

Next stop is a short walk to **Yamamoto Keiko Rochaix** (6 min) for a solo exhibition by Yoi Kawakubo, known for his large scale wall installations. Second stop, visit **Studio 1.1** (15 mins) for the opening of **David Lock**'s society portraiture show. For your last stop, head to **Hundred Years Gallery** (15 min) to see the culmination of a year's residency series, organised by **Hundred Years Gallery** and **Great Art**, that aims to capture the spirit of open collaboration and community arts.
