

HLF Skills for the Future Traineeships:

Non-Graduate pre-Recruitment Workshops

Supported by the Heritage Lottery Fund, over the next two years the Whitechapel Gallery will be recruiting six Trainees per year to work in six different departments, commencing in 2014.

Traineeships focus on high quality, work-based accredited training, with additional in-house workshops, visits to museums, galleries, and archives, and monthly career mentoring sessions. Contracts are for one year, with a £13,000 bursary.

On completion, Trainees are awarded an EDI level 3 diploma in Cultural Heritage. The programme aims to bring new and diverse talent into the heritage sector, and to provide an entry route into cultural employment for those with little prior work experience.

The Whitechapel Gallery will be running two pre-recruitment workshop sessions for non-graduate candidates in February 2014:

Saturday 8 February 2014 – 11am-3pm

Saturday 15 February 2014 - 11am-3pm

These sessions will aim to provide an overview of Whitechapel Gallery and the Skills for the Future programme, and to offer bespoke CV and application writing advice to non-graduates who are interested in applying.
