

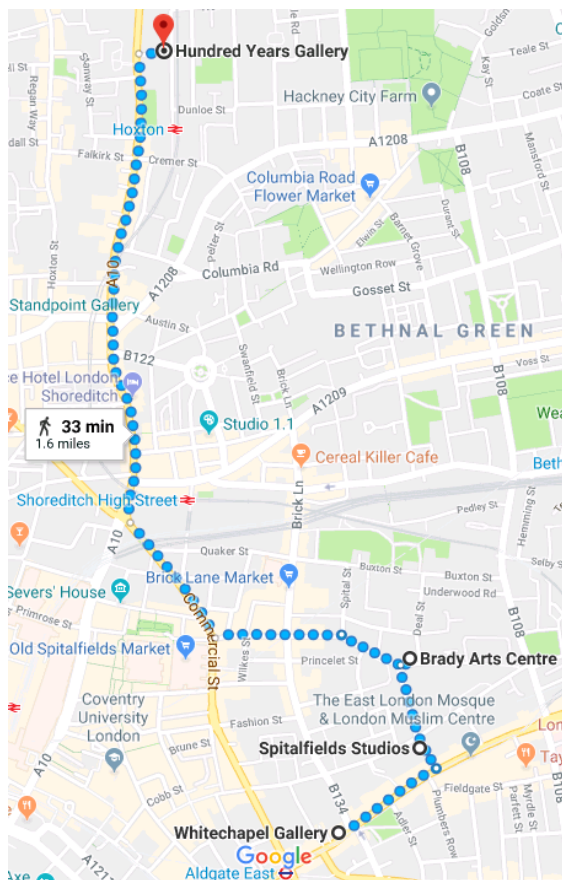
Whitechapel Gallery First Thursdays



Late night art on the first Thursday of every month in east London

May's Walking Tour begins at **Whitechapel Gallery**. Enter the immersive exhibition *Mark Dion: Theatre of the Natural World* (tickets available from the Gallery information desk) and see the first overview of the Crossrail artworks in *Art Capital: Art for the Elizabeth line* (free entry).

Next stop is a short walk to **Spitalfields Studios** (4 min) where 14 artists will be taking over the building, with a showcase of painting, printmaking, photography and installation. Visit **Brady Arts Centre** (3 min) to see a striking selection of posters, photographs and prints documenting protests and demonstrations in the fight for tolerance and anti-racism, particularly around Whitechapel and Brick Lane. For your last stop, head to **Hundred Years Gallery** (26 min) where Julie Ann and Julia Maddison have used the wall of the gallery as a giant scrapbook, to display images and objects illustrating the freedoms and complexities of their lives as artists.
