
Whitechapel Gallery FIRST Thursday of every month in east London

December's Walking Tour begins at **Whitechapel Gallery**. Enter the immersive exhibition, *Elmgreen & Dragset: This Is How We Bite Our Tongue* (tickets available from the Info Desk).

Free entry to all other displays including *Ulla von Brandenburg: Sweet Feast, Surreal Science:* Loudon Collection with Salvatore Arancio, Staging Jackson Pollock and Mikhail Karikis: No Ordinary Protest.

The next stop is a short walk to **Gallery S O** (5 min) to see *The Possibility of Someone*, a new body of work by contemporary jeweller **Manon van Kouswijk**. Second stop is **Beers London** (22 min) for the group exhibition *15 Works on Paper*. The 15 works on display span a spectrum of media, subject matter, and styles. Finally, head to **PEER** (12 min) for *the image unseen, the image invisible, the image not shown* a moving image exhibition by **Belit Sa**ğ in partnership with LUX that examines larger political topics in a personal and often intimate way.
