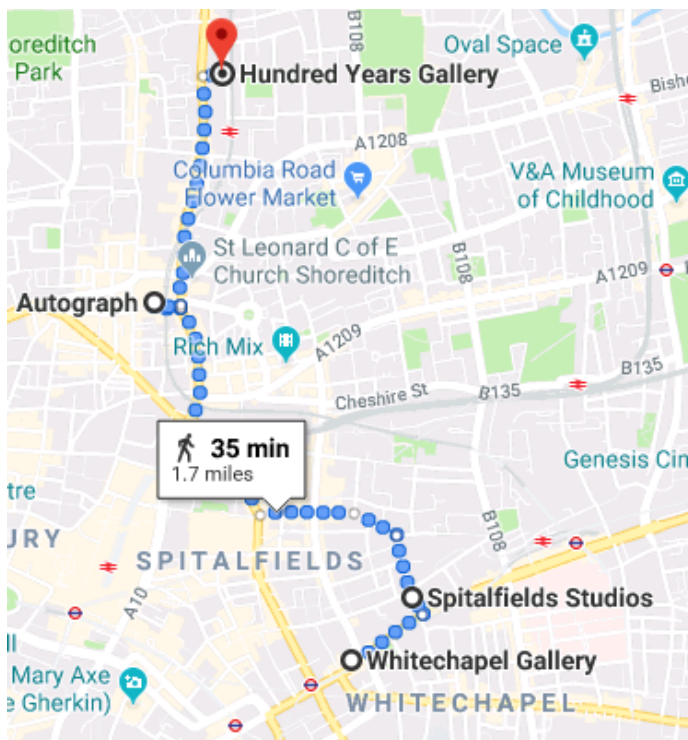
# First Thursdays



Late night art on the first Thursday of every month in east London

June's Walking Tour begins at **Whitechapel Gallery** with an opportunity to see our new *Michael Rakowitz* exhibition and a last chance to see *City Poems & City Music*. Plus free displays: *Queer Spaces: London, 1980s – Today*, *"la Caixa" Collection of Contemporary Art: Selected by Maria Fusco* and *Setting the Table: Village Politics* by Myvillages.

Next stop is a short walk to **Spitalfields Studios** (4 mins) for the solo show of **David Kendall**. *Measuring Silences* is a photography exhibition that responds to architectural change, collective memory and migration inside and outside cities. Second stop is **Autograph ABP** (20 mins) for **Lola Flash**'s first major solo exhibition in London, *[sur]passing*. Flash's practice is firmly rooted in social justice advocacy, inviting an open-ended, intersectional conversation around sexual, racial and cultural difference. Also on display is *Untitled*, where **Maxine Walker** uses photography to interrogate the intricacies of skin, blackness and being. Finally, head to **Hundred Years Gallery** (11 mins) for the opening of the group exhibition *CHANGE*, including performances by several of the artists.
