You do not need a ticket to access this event. It is free to watch.

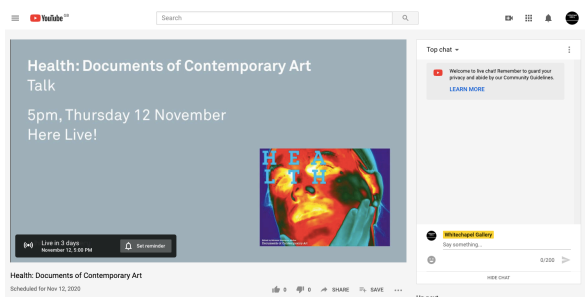
Please be aware that the event is suitable for those over the age of 16. The event may include content that is not suitable for younger audiences.

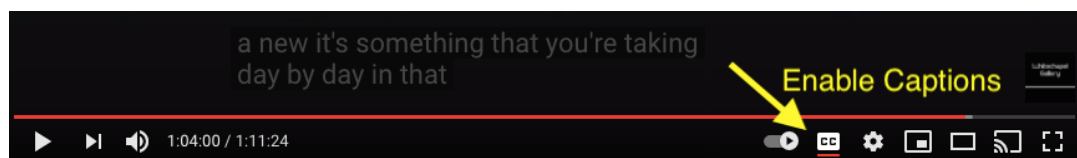

The event contains both pre-recorded and live content, which will be live captioned during the stream. To enable the captions you will need to click the 'CC' button in the bottom right hand corner of the player.

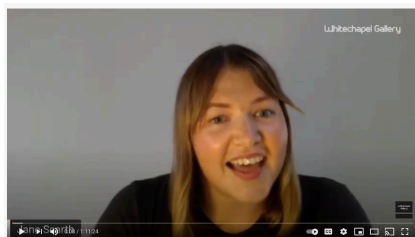


Taking Breaks:

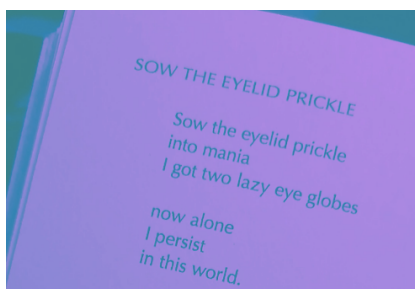
What to expect during the event:
