## Inês Neto dos Santos 'Beans (a love letter)', 2021



Relax with a drink and a snack in the bean bar with views over East London to experience an installation of bean plants, documentation of the bean network @lovelettertobeans, and pick up a free bean seed pack. You can also enjoy a three-course meal in collaboration with Townsend Restaurant. All these form part of artist Inês Neto dos Santos's (b.1992 Lisbon) project Beans (a love letter). Drawing inspiration from beans' regenerative and resilient nature, this work explores how food growing and sharing can be a metaphor for living in greater connection with our surroundings and others.

Inês Neto dos Santos collaborates with plant, microbial and human friends to expand our understanding of our enmeshed, multi-species existence. Inviting local participants to plant beans over the summer as part of a bean-growing

network, Neto dos Santos encourages us to think about the plant's life cycle, its regenerative properties and how food can connect people.
