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About

Whitechapel Gallery offers a unique setting for corporate events, receptions and private functions.

Founded in 1901, to ‘bring great art to the people of the East End London’, the Whitechapel Gallery occupies a distinctive Arts and Crafts building designed by Charles Harrison Townsend, and re-opened its expanded premises in 2009. The building now houses eight galleries, a restaurant, an auditorium, an archive, library and a dedicated education and research tower.

The education and research tower boasts a beautiful Creative Studio overlooking the rooftops of the city, which provides a stunning setting for daytime and evening events. The former Whitechapel Library, now Gallery 2, retains its original Victorian exposed brickwork and polished concrete floor, creating a versatile backdrop for events of all styles.

Whatever you need, the experienced and imaginative Venue Hire team will be there to assist you in creating your perfect event.

The Whitechapel Gallery is a registered charity and by choosing the Gallery for your event you are also supporting the Gallery’s educational and community programmes.

The Study Studio is fully equipped with designer furniture and built-in AV facilities. It also holds two artworks from the Gallery's social sculpture series, which encourage contemplation and discussion.

This space is excellent for board meetings, presentations and small evening receptions.

Gallery 3 is a versatile space with two social sculptures by artist **Liam Gillick**, who has created a maze like mural on the ceiling and transcribed the wall-mounted mirror. Access to the space is via Gallery 1 or Gallery 2, so is well matched to a guided tour of one of our exhibitions.

The Gallery is good for seminars, intimate dinners and drinks receptions.

By Underground

We are less than 1 minute walk from Aldgate East Underground station. Liverpool Street and Tower Gateway and Shoreditch High Street Overground are 15 minutes walks from the Gallery.

By Bus

The 25, 205 and 254 stop outside the Gallery. The 15, 115, 40, 42, 45 and 67 buses stop outside Aldgate Station. The 35, 43, 78, 149, 242, 344 and 388 stop on Commercial Road. The 242 and 253 stop outside Liverpool Street Station.

Cycling

The nearest docking stations for Barclays Cycle Hire are at Altab Ali Park, Aldgate East, with 15 docking stations, and Braham Street, Aldgate, with 34 docking stations available.
