Exhibition Guide

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This is the night mail crossing the Border, Bringing the cheque and the postal order, Letters for the rich, letters for the poor, The shop at the corner, the girl next door. ... Letters of thanks, letters from banks, Letters of joy from girl and boy, Receipted bills and invitations ...

This is the Night Mail is the first line of W.H. Auden's 1936 poem describing a train crossing a sleeping Britain as it carries the nation's mail. It featured in a film commissioned by the Post Office with a soundtrack by composer Benjamin Britten. The poem has inspired Norwegian artist Ida Ekblad (b. 1980) in her selection of works from the Christen Sveaas Art Foundation.

Ekblad is renowned for her polychromatic, gestural paintings that can expand into immersive environments. Coming from the land of both the longest and the shortest night, she shares with the artists featured here a fascination with the nocturne. Ekblad explores how moonlit interiors, land and seascapes frame dreams, dramas and transgressions. She includes 19th century and 20th century masterpieces by Norwegian artists from abstract planetary compositions by Anna-Eva Bergman and disturbing fantasies by Theodor Kittelsen to psychologically-charged nightscapes by Edvard Munch and romantic nocturnes by Harald Sohlberg. Imagining the display as three train compartments, Ekblad juxtaposes these modern masters with contemporary artists whose works also explore the romantic encounters, bad behaviour and fantasies sanctioned by the darkness. The display also includes beautifully-crafted antique silver and glass objects

redolent of intoxication and pleasure and vessels containing wine – or sleeping draughts.

Christen Syeaas Art Foundation

Continuing the Whitechapel Gallery's programme of presenting international collections rarely seen in the UK, this display is drawn from the renowned collection of the Christen Sveaas Art Foundation.

Christen Sveaas is a Norwegian businessman, collector and philanthropist who has collected art and antique silver for more than 40 years. He began his art collection with late 19th century and early 20th century Norwegian artists including Johan Christian Dahl, Edvard Munch and Harald Sohlberg.

The collection's focus is primarily painting with some sculpture and photography and is made up of more than 2000 works of art by over 300 artists. In 1996 Christen Sveaas founded the Kistefos Museum on the grounds of his grandfather Anders Sveaas' old wood pulp mill at Jevnaker, north of Oslo. The museum has one of the most important sculpture parks in Europe,

an industrial museum and two exhibition spaces for contemporary art. In 2019 Christen Sveaas established the Christen Sveaas Art Foundation which the following year received some 800 works of art from his personal collection to be made available to Norwegian and international museums.

From August 2021 to January 2023, the Whitechapel Gallery is presenting a series of exhibitions, each conceived by an artist whose work is held in the collection.
