In continuation of his Confidential Memorandum of the 24th inst., the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis would suggest for the consideration of the Authorities the advisability of leaving muffs and parcels at the entrance to Museums and Art Galleries, as umbrellas are now left. This practice has long existed at some Galleries but, so far as the Commissioner is aware, is not general.
