




Our Exhibitions


Our exhibitions are always changing.

Visiting the free exhibitions

Our free exhibitions are in the right-side of the building.

Gallery 2 shows free films. It is on the ground floor.

Galleries 4, 5, 6 and 7 are free. They are all upstairs.

You can use the stairs or the lift.



Visiting the paid exhibitions

You need to buy a ticket for some exhibitions.


A concession ticket is £9.50.

Companions can enter with you for free.

The paid exhibitions start in Gallery 1.

It is next to the Front Desk.








Inside the galleries

The cloakroom is free.



Seating area

You are welcome to rest in the seating area.


You can bring any food or drinks here.
